General Raffle Rules & Regulations

The raffle is sponsored by and will benefit Children's Health Council (hereafter referred to as "CHC"), a non-profit organization # 941312311 located at 650 Clark Way, Palo Alto, California.

Individual raffle tickets are \$20 each. A pack of three tickets is \$50. A pack of seven tickets is \$100. Odds of winning depend on the total number of tickets sold. A maximum of 3,000 tickets will be sold. Per IRS regulations, the purchase of a raffle ticket is not tax-deductible as a charitable contribution.

Only one name/entrant is permitted per ticket number.

Eligibility: The raffle is open to all US residents including employees, volunteers, and representative of CHC. Void where prohibited by law and subject to all Federal, State and local taxes and regulations.

Tickets are on sale from October 11th to October 18th at Noon (presale) and also at the Rocktoberfest event from 6:00pm – 9pm (unless tickets sell out before that time) on October 19th.

Tickets will be sold by CHC staff and volunteers. Tickets may be purchased by cash, credit card or check made payable to Children's Health Council. Event attendees may pre-register a credit card at Rocktoberfest and purchase via their bid number. Raffle tickets are non-transferable.

No refunds will be made except under the following circumstances: Any presale ticket order received after 12 noon on October 18th. CHC assumes no responsibility for lost, late, misdirected or non-delivered mail or messages, or any other failure to receive orders or deliver receipts prior to the drawing deadlines.

The raffle drawing will be held at CHC, 650 Clark Way, Palo Alto, CA on October 21, 2019 at approximately 12 Noon. Only 1 ticket will be drawn for each prize. Winners need not be present to win. Winners will be notified on October 21, 2019 according to the contact information provided to CHC at the time of ticket purchase. A winner's prize will be forfeited if (1) the winner cannot be located by 5pm November 1st, 2019 after CHC has made reasonable attempts to contact them using the information provided at the time of purchasing the ticket, (2) the winner fails to confirm eligibility and acceptance of the prize within 3 business days of receiving CHC's notification or by 5pm November 1, 2019 whichever is later. If a winner forfeits a prize, an alternate winner will be selected. In order to collect his/her prize, the winner must show proof of identity such that CHC can confirm the person claiming the prize is the same person who is named on the winning raffle ticket. The winner must also provide the winning ticket stub or purchase/email confirmation with winning number.

Prizes may not be exchanged for cash value or substituted. Prizes are awarded "AS-IS" without warranty of any kind, either express or implied, and CHC hereby disclaims all such warranties, including but not limited to, the implied warranties of merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose.

General conditions: The winner agrees that all prizes are awarded on the condition that Children's Health Council, its agents, volunteers, representatives and employees will have no liability whatsoever for any injuries, losses or damages of any kind resulting from acceptance, possession, use, misuse or non-use of the prizes (including any travel related thereto) that may be awarded. All personal income taxes, sales, or use taxes or any other taxes or fees whatsoever are the sole responsibility of the winner.

All decisions and interpretations of the rules and regulations are of Children's Health Council and its judgement is final.
