



## **Community Education Curriculum Product Developer Teen Initiative**

### **SUMMARY**

**Manage the development of a set of 20+ user-friendly classes for parents, teachers and teens on the topic of teen anxiety, depression and suicide. Classes will be appropriate for both face-to-face delivery and online access.**

[Children's Health Council](#) is looking for an experienced curriculum developer to work at the agency for 8-12 months in a term of project capacity. We recently launched an initiative to address teen anxiety, depression and suicide in the community and one of our primary commitments is to develop parent, teacher and teen education addressing this topic and get it into the community as quickly and as widely as possible. Our vision is to create a quality collection of approximately twenty 90 minute classes whose content can be adapted for parents, teachers and teens and which can be delivered both face to face and online. We would also like to deliver the content in Spanish. A description of the comprehensive suite of classes needs to be ready by July 2016 and at least 10 of the classes themselves must be ready for delivery by September 2016. We are also planning to host a CHC Teen Symposium sometime in 2017.
